

AFP Quad Cities Chapter Guidelines for Scholarships

The following scholarships will be provided by the AFP Quad Cities Chapter:

AFP Conference Scholarship - \$500.00 (AFP Quad City Chapter Member Benefit)

- Must be a member of the Quad City Chapter of AFP.
- Same criteria as Chamberlain Scholarship
- Same application as Chamberlain Scholarship
- Decision to be made same as Chamberlain Scholarship
- Due Date same as Chamberlain Scholarship

Dues Assistance Scholarships

(AFP Quad City Chapter Member Benefit & New AFP Quad City Chapter Member Benefit)

- Available to new or renewing members of the Quad City Chapter of AFP.
- One scholarship will be awarded per quarter.
- One scholarship for 50% of appropriate dues for new or renewing member.
- Submit Letter of Request to Deb Sandry, Membership Co-Chair; c/o Quad City Symphony, 327 Brady Street, Davenport, IA 52801 or e-mail to dsandry@qcsymphony.com.
- Member or prospective member must submit an essay explaining the need for assistance at this time and efforts to be made to have funding available for membership the following year.
- All letters must contain: Name, Position, Organization, Address, and Phone Number. Also include number of years in fundraising and if member, number of years as AFP Member.
- Quarterly due dates for applications are the third Wednesday of July, October, January, and April. Announcements will be made following the August, November, February and May Board of Directors meeting.
- Renewing members apply one quarter in advance of your renewal date.
- New members apply for any quarter using above due dates.
- Recommendation will be made by the membership committee with the Board of Directors making the final decision.

Yearly Scholarships for nationally sanctioned classes offered by the Quad City AFP Chapter – 50% of Tuition

(AFP Quad City Chapter Member Benefit)

- Must be a member of the Quad City Chapter of AFP.
- On Class Registration Form, registrants will be asked if there is a need for financial assistance with this class.
- From among those registrants indicating a need for assistance, a drawing will be held to award up to 3 scholarships.

Chamberlain Scholarship Program
